ROBY

ROBY

SADIE

ROBY

ROBY

SADIE

HOLT

ROBY

SADIE

ROBY

In somebody's briefcase.

SADIE

Who do you know has a briefcase filled with this much money?

ROBY

You need your heart fixed. Right?

SADIE

Yeah.

ROBY

All right. Here's a lesson for you... Sometimes it's okay to kick a puppy.

SADIE

ROBY  
*Sometimes.* For a good reason.

SADIE  
I don't think there's ever a good reason to kick a puppy.

ROBY  
Not even if it was a puppy filled with money?

HOLT  
Maybe if it's a not-very-nice puppy.

ROBY  
See, Holt's on the right track. But in this case, it *is* a nice puppy, but—

HOLT  
I'm saying if it was a not-very-nice puppy, is what I'm sayin.

ROBY  
That ain't what I'm sayin.

HOLT  
Probably shouldn't kick a nice puppy.

ROBY  
Do you want your heart fixed or not?

SADIE

ROBY

ROBY
